Dr. Burks Reviewed what they plan to do for improvements (Here were a few ideas)

- Strategies as Parent/Guardian Volunteer.
- There are several areas to improve
- Parents broke out into sessions to provide success ideas to support these efforts
- Parents can get involved by completing trainings to volunteer in the classroom
- Mental health awareness events advertise more
- Start Earlier to prepare for the Maryland exam
- Letting students know where they stand
- Transparency of students' levels in ELA/Math
- Homework so parents can understand where the students are and partner at home
- Enforcement of strategies
- Moving to standard report cards
